### ● CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

This championship is open to all male and female amateur golfers who are between the ages of 13 -18 as of February 24, 2007. All entrants must have an official handicap that is verifiable by a handicap chairman, PGA professional, or golf coach. Each entry must accompany a parental or guardian's signature and the consent release form. Entry forms are subject to approval or rejection by the Central Florida Junior Golf Tour Committee (CFJGTC). **A copy of entrant's verifiable proof of age must accompany the official entry forms.**

### ● FIELD

The field may be limited to 90 players. Each age division will have a limit but may go up or down depending on entrants..

### ● ENTRY PROCEDURE

1.) All entries must be submitted on the official entry form. Additional entry forms may be obtained by logging onto

Late, incomplete, or inaccurate entry forms are not acceptable. We will not accept faxed entry forms. Entries will be accepted on a first received basis.



2.) All entry fees must be mailed or delivered to the Central Florida Junior Golf Tour Committee, YMCA Par 3, 1740 George Jenkins Blvd, Lakeland, FL, 33815 and arrive prior to 6:00 p.m. of the entry deadline on Friday, February 2nd, 2007.

3.) The entry cost is \$100. The entry fee must accompany the official entry forms and should be payable in U.S. funds. Acceptable forms of payment include CHECK, MONEY ORDER, CREDIT CARD (Visa, Mastercard, and Discover), or CASH (must be hand delivered).

### ● REFUND OF ENTRY

Entry fee will be refunded regardless of reason if CFJGT office is notified before entries close (February 2nd). After entries close, entry fee will be refunded only for injury or illness (doctor's letter required) if requested by February 16, 2007. After November 3rd no refund will be given. There is a \$20 service charge on all withdrawals.

### ● TOURNAMENT ACCEPTANCE

Players will receive a notification of acceptance in the mail once the applicant's official entry has been approved by the CFJGTC and all accepted applicants names will be posted on the CFJGT Website shortly after the deadline.

### ● **FORMAT**

The Central Florida Junior Golf Invitational is a 36 hole stroke play competition.

### ● **COMPETITION**

The official USGA Rules of Golf shall govern all play. Rules officials will be dispersed throughout the golf course to assist players in determining the proper procedures. All decisions regarding the Rules of Golf made by designated rules officials during the tournament are considered final.

### ● **PRACTICE**

For all practice rounds, the contestant must make individual arrangements with The Golf Club at BridgeWater. To reserve your practice round time, each participant should contact The Golf Club at BridgeWater. If you would like to be paired with any other individual(s) for your practice round, please arrange when calling the proshop.

### ● **CADDIES AND CARTS**

No player may ride in a motorized golf cart during the course of the competition. Players may, however, ride in the tournament-approved shuttles dispersed throughout the host facility during tournament rounds and may get transportation during the occurrence of having to travel back and replay a ball that was deemed out of bounds. Players in all divisions may not have a caddy accompany them during tournament rounds and must carry their own bag or use a pull cart.

### ● **DRESS CODE**

Proper attire is required at all times while using the golf facility at The Golf Club at BridgeWater. Any violation will result in the player not being allowed to participate until the contestant has met the regulations. The Golf Club at BridgeWater prohibits the usage of metal spikes, short shorts, tank tops, t-shirts, and denim shorts and jeans. Golf shirts must be tucked in and not contain slogans, language or pictures that may be interpreted as being offensive. All hats and caps must be worn in the manner in which they were intended, frontwards not backwards.

### ● **CONTESTANT CONDUCT**

The following actions will be considered violations of the Conduct Code prescribed by the CFJGTC: Any abusive language, club throwing, cheating, disrespect of tournament volunteers or The Golf Club at BridgeWater employees, abuse of golf course, leaving the course during your competitive round without the consent from a tournament official, any use or association with drugs or alcohol, not adhering to the dress code during any portion of the tournament proper, vandalism, and/or any other behaviors which may be deemed unbecoming of a tournament contestant as interpreted by the CFJGTC. The penalty for such violations, based on the severity of the conduct, may be any or all of the following: a warning, disqualification of the player from the tournament, or suspension of player from future championships. Contestants must turn off cell phones or pagers during official tournament rounds.

### ● **SPECTATORS**

Spectators are welcome and may follow players in all divisions with a motorized golf cart. The tournament committee encourages spectators and the acknowledgement of good play, provided it does not interfere with other competitors. A violation of the spectator rules will result in penalty strokes or disqualification for the junior participant involved. It is the junior golfer's responsibility to make sure spectators do not cause a violation.

Rules which must be followed:

1. The junior participant is not to receive any advice from spectator (parents, relatives, or friends). Some examples of advice are:
  - Verbal communication with the participant.
  - Hand signals to the participant, including gestures to influence player decisions.
  - Providing participants with written material
  - Positioning yourself as a spectator to assist the junior participant with aim or alignment.

2. Whenever possible, spectators are requested to stay 25 yards from the participants to the side of fairways, tees, and greens. Please do not follow directly behind the participants, as this often prevents the next group from being able to hit their shots.

### ● **TEE TIMES**

Pairings will be posted on our website [www.centralfloridajuniorgolftour.com](http://www.centralfloridajuniorgolftour.com) 7 days before the tournament date. On the day of competition, players are reminded to arrive at their respective starting hole ten minutes prior to their individual starting time. Players not arriving on time shall be penalized according to the breach as defined by the Rules of Golf.

### ● **TOURNAMENT RANKING POINTS**

This event is a nationally ranked tournament by the Junior Golf Scoreboard.

### ● **SCORING AND AWARDS**

Upon the completion of each round, contestants must sign their official scorecard and submit it to the proper tournament-scoring table. It is the responsibility of the contestants to ensure scoring integrity is maintained.

Ties will be broken by a sudden-death playoff immediately upon the conclusion of play in each Division.

Determination of winners and places in CFJGT events. In the event of ties: The first place winner within each age group will be determined by a sudden death playoff. Ties for other trophies are decided by a scorecard playoff according to the U.S.G.A. Tournament rules and regulations. In the event of adverse weather conditions or darkness, ties may be determined by a scorecard playoff. All decisions made by CFJGT tournament officials related to scoring are final. Awards for each division will be immediately dispensed upon the conclusion of play in each Division.

### ● **TOURNAMENT WINNERS**

The winning male and female juniors of each of the four divisions will receive (1) exemption toward a Florida Junior Tour (FJT) event.

### ● **DIRECTIONS**

The Golf Club at BridgeWater is centrally located between Orlando and Tampa on SR 33, just South of I-4.

From Orlando, take I-4 to Exit 38, turn left and go south 1 mile. The Golf Club at BridgeWater is on the right.

From Tampa, take I-4 to Exit 38, turn right and go south 1 mile. The Golf Club at BridgeWater will be on the right.
